“ Though bee products are not essential to cosmetics, their characteristics add to the various care products **in a way no other single products can**. Propolis is possibly the most commonly used in creams for various dermatological and cosmetic applications. Its effect on tissue regeneration and renovation has been well documented. Its antibacterial, antifungal, stimulating and rejuvenating effects add greatly to the existing properties of a well balanced and formulated moisturising cream.
